Updated LACDPH COVID-19 Guidelines

- The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health (LACDPH) has issued updated [COVID-19 Reporting Requirements](#).
- Compton College will continue to follow the LACDPH's [COVID-19 and Acute Respiratory Illness \(ARI\) Guidelines for Education Settings](#) and adhere to all requirements outlined by [Cal/OSHA COVID-19 Prevention Non-Emergency Regulations](#).
- Employees and students with a COVID-19 infection need to adhere to [LACDPH Instructions for COVID-19 Cases and Close Contacts](#), regardless of their vaccination status, history of previous infection, or lack of symptoms.
 - Individuals with COVID-19 with symptoms: Individuals who have COVID-19 and are experiencing symptoms shall stay home away from others until fever-free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medication AND other symptoms are mild and improving. Masks are required to leave isolation before ten days from when symptoms began or the date of their first positive test when around other people. You can remove your mask sooner if you have two sequential negative tests at least one day apart.
 - Individuals with COVID-19 without symptoms: Individuals who have COVID-19 and are not experiencing symptoms are not required to isolate provided they wear a well-fitting, high-quality respiratory mask whenever around other people. You can remove your mask sooner if you have two sequential negative tests at least one day apart.
