All supportive information must be submitted along with the application for admission consideration. No Exceptions!

1. Previous academic degrees or diplomas, or relevant health care certificates held by an applicant – Maximum Points = 12		
1a. AA, AS, BS/BA degrees or higher	5	Official transcript from regionally accredited U.S. colleges or universities with degree posted. All transcripts from outside the United States must be evaluated by a Compton College-approved foreign evaluation service (Only highest degree will be considered)
1b. LVN, Paramedic, Psychiatric Technician, Radiologic Technician, or Respiratory Therapist. Work experience in direct acute patient care > 1000 hours of work experience	5	Licensed or certificated healthcare worker requires a copy of your current <i>California</i> certificate including your certificate number, date of issue and date of expiration. Work: Letter from current/former employee verifying employment. The letter must be on organization letterhead with an original signature and must include applicant's name, start date and end date (if applicable), employee status (full-time/part-time), number of hours worked per week (or total hours from/to date), job title, department if applicable, and examples of duties including patient interaction.
1c. Certified health care worker e.g. CNA, HHA, EMT, MA, Phlebotomist, documented medical military experience > 1000 hours of work experience	5	Licensed or certificated healthcare worker with recent work experience in direct patient care.
1d. School Health Aides, Unlicensed Assistants, Personal (UAP), Clinical Care Extender, Adapted Kinesiology Assistant, Hospital unit based clerical or telemetry staff or Physical Therapy Aide	2	Work or volunteer experience related to direct human patient care > 1000 hours (same as 1b).
1e. Volunteer with direct patient care contact with >200 hours experience	2	Letter from current/former organization verifying volunteer service. The letter must be on organization letterhead with an original signature and must include applicant's name, start date and end date (if applicable), number of hours volunteered and examples of duties including patient interaction.
2. Grade point average in relevant course work – Maximum Points = 50		
2a. Minimum 2.5 GPA in Science Prerequisites: Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology. <i>Note: No more than one repeat of any substandard grade in the basic science prerequisite will be allowed within 7 years of the application filing date.</i> GPA = 4.0 GPA = 3.5 GPA = 3.0 GPA = 2.5	25 20 15 10	Official transcripts (in original sealed/unopened envelope) for all lower and upper division courses completed at any and all regionally accredited U.S. institutions, regardless of applicability to nursing requirements will be required. Official transcripts will not be required for courses completed at Compton College. All transcripts from outside the United States must be evaluated by a Compton College approved foreign evaluation service. Courses completed at other regionally accredited United States colleges or universities must be equivalent to Compton College courses. For determination of course equivalency, course descriptions (must come from the specific catalog year in which the course was taken may be available at http://www.collegesource.org/) must accompany official transcripts . No course descriptions are required for prerequisites completed at Compton College. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better and the final grade must be posted on the transcript. For any course in which a grade of "C" or better was earned, the EARLIEST course grade will be utilized. Failure to submit transcripts with all grades posted will result in disqualification from the application process.

Low family income <i>(Eligibility for, or receipt of, financial aid under a program that may include, but not limited to, a fee waiver from the Board of Governors, the Cal Grant Program, the federal Pell Grant program or CalWORKs)</i>		Proof of eligibility or proof of receipt of financial aid e.g. Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGFW), Cal Grant, Pell Grant or other federal grant, CalWORKs
3c. First generation to attend college		Complete the <u>ADN Admission Supporting Documentation Form</u> explaining situation or circumstances
3d. Need to work <i>(Need to work means student is working at least part-time while completing academic work that is prerequisite for the Nursing Program)</i>		Paycheck stub during period of time enrolled in prerequisite courses or letter from employer (must be on organization letterhead) verifying employment was at least part-time while completing prerequisite courses
3e. Disadvantaged social or educational environment		Participation or eligibility for Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS)
3f. Difficult personal and family situation/circumstances		Complete <u>ADN Admission Supporting Documentation Form</u> explaining situation or circumstances
3g. Refugee status		Documentation or letter from United States Citizens and Immigration Service (USCIS)
3h. Proficiency in a language other than English		Complete <u>ADN Admission Supporting Documentation Form</u> providing proof of proficiency based one of the following: a) Completed verification form from professor, clergy, or supervisor (must speak, read and write in the language). b) Transcripts showing completion of 3 years of high school in same language with a “C” or better, or 2 years in college through the intermediate level.

4. Veterans Status - Maximum Points = 3 Points Applicant must submit <u>ALL</u> required supporting documentation to be eligibility for veteran credit		
Veteran	3	Submit acceptable documentation of veteran status or eligible as spouse a) Copy of Defense Department Form 214 (DD 214) Honorable Discharge or b) Copy of official notice issued by the department of Defense documenting the active duty status of spouse.
5. Approved diagnostic Assessment Tool Maximum points = 25		
Assessment/readiness test results (ATI TEAS). Only the first passing score will count towards TEAS ranking.
