
Student Success

- Compton College is a certified Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) as designated by the U.S. Department of Education, enabling the college to access additional resources to better serve students.
- Compton College continues to provide enrolled students with a wealth of free benefits and resources including laptop computer and WiFi hotspot loans, waived enrollment fees (*see page 2), health care services, food and housing referrals, pass/no pass grading options, online tutoring & academic support, and more.
- Since 2019, a combined total of 290 students from Compton Early College High School and Paramount College and Career Access Pathways have graduated with both a diploma and an associate degree through Compton College's partnership with the Compton and Paramount unified school districts.
- The first cohort of the College and Career Access Pathway students from Paramount High School graduated from Compton College in June 2023. Twenty-four high school students earned an associate degree or certificate in career/ technical education.

- *Beginning in fall 2023, the **Compton College Oliver W. Conner Promise Program** (enrollment fee waiver program) was expanded to include all eligible first-time college students regardless of their age or whether they live within the Compton College service area or not. First-time college students attend two years nearly cost free!
- Regardless of immigration status, Compton College is open to all students who seek a higher education and meet the
 minimum requirements for admission. The college provides resources and assistance, for undocumented/AB 540 students,
 with enrollment and completion of their academic goals.
- The award-winning **Formerly Incarcerated Students in Transition (F.I.S.T.)** program provides equity, diversity and access to this student population. F.I.S.T. received the Dr. John W. Rice Diversity & Equity Award in 2017.
- Compton College has Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) agreements with the following colleges and universities: UC
 Davis, UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara, UC Santa Cruz, and Arizona State. TAG agreements are also available
 with over 30 Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) such as Alabama State, Clark Atlanta, Fisk, and Tuskegee.
- Compton College offers three types of no-fee Dual Enrollment courses for local high school students. 1) For Compton and Paramount Unified school districts, AB 288 courses that provide access to career education and/or university transfer pathways. 2) Afternoon College (courses offered at high school sites after the regular school day) for all local districts served by Compton College. 3) Compton Early College, a collaboration with Compton Unified School District where students can earn both a high school diploma and two years of college credit toward an associate degree simultaneously.
