Compton Community College District Looking for Community Members Interested in Serving on Redistricting Committee

Apply Today to Help Determine New Board of Trustees Area Boundaries for Voting Purposes

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) is currently accepting applications for consideration from those who are interested in serving on the District's Redistricting Committee. Letters of interest must be submitted to the Office of the CEO by 4:30 p.m. on November 2, 2021.

Every 10 years, local community colleges, city councils and other local agencies must adjust their elected trustee area boundaries to equalize the population. How and where district boundaries are drawn can shape communities' ability to elect the representatives of their choice.

Governing Boards of community college districts are required, by the end of February 28, 2022, to adjust the boundaries of any or all trustee areas by using census population figures from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Census Bureau decennial census of the country's population conducted in 2020 and validated by the Population Research Unit of the California Department of Finance.

The Redistricting Committee members will be appointed by the President/CEO of the Compton Community College District. The committee will comprise at least one member from each of the CCCD's five current trustee areas. Committee members will review and provide input regarding the redistricting proposals for new trustee area boundaries.

Help ensure that each voice in your community can be represented fairly by participating in the creation of districts with the same number of people. Interested applicants should submit a one-page letter of interest along with a resume, to Keith Curry, President/CEO of the Compton Community College District, at 1111 E.
