President/CEO Closing the Loop

I am excited to share some fantastic news with you all. What started as a recommendation from Board of Trustees Vice President Sonia Lopez during our visit to Washington, D.C., in *February 2025* has now become a reality. We have successfully installed a County of Los Angeles Community Health Kiosk on campus, located between the cafeteria and the Bookstore.

This self-serve vending machine dispenses free COVID-19 Antigen tests, harm-reduction products, sexual health supplies, and educational materials. I want to extend my gratitude to Reuben James, director of Purchasing and Auxiliary Services, for his collaboration with the Los Angeles Department of Public Health, which made this possible. The first of two kiosks has been installed, marking a significant milestone in our commitment to community health. We are proud to be the first community college in Los Angeles County to request and receive such a kiosk. This initiative is a game-changer for our campus, and I believe it will have a positive impact on the well-being of our community.

Final Thoughts

As we wrap up this week's update, I want to share some important news. Our Vice President of Administrative Services, Dr. Abdul Nasser, has submitted his letter of resignation, effective *June 30, 2025*, due to health concerns.

I want to extend my heartfelt thanks to Dr. Nasser for his expertise and dedication to the fiscal well-being of the Compton Community College District. His assistance with budget and facilities has been invaluable. Dr. Nasser joined us on *January 19, 2021*, midway through the pandemic, and his leadership during these challenging times has been greatly appreciated.

One of Dr. Nasser's final assignments will be assisting with the hiring of his replacement, ensuring a smooth transition for our administrative services. This afternoon, Human Resources will begin the recruitment for the Vice President of Administrative Services position, with an anticipated start date of *July 1*, 2025.

Additionally, I would like to announce the retirement of our Director of Admissions & Records, Richette Bell. Richette's last day will be *April 4, 2025*. Richette is retiring after 12 years of dedicated service to Compton College students. Her commitment and contributions have greatly impacted our community, and we are grateful for her years of service.

We will announce the interim Director of Admissions and Records position this afternoon. The interim position will be open for seven days, and both internal and external applicants are welcome to apply.
